First Grade

Please purchase a traditional two-strap backpack **without wheels** (no satchels, please) for your first grader. Lunch bags or boxes should fit within the backpack. Miss Zepeda will assemble a kit of everything the students will need this year. This is more convenient, more cost effective, and ensures that all the students will have the same supplies. Parents will be required to pay about \$20 **in cash** directly to Miss Zepeda for these supplies at the beginning of the school year. In addition, please purchase, to keep in backpack for use at home and at school:

- 1 set of addition flashcards
- 1 set of subtraction flashcards
- 1 set of colored pencils for home (for use in Saxon math homework)

Second Grade
